Kyle Womack was born and raised in West Texas. He attended Permian High School and graduated 7<sup>th</sup> in his class in 1971. Kyle graduated from Texas Tech University in 1975 with a degree in Civil Engineering. While at Tech, Kyle was a member of Chi Epsilon and Tau Beta Pi – both engineering honorary fraternities. He became a registered Professional Engineer in 1980.
